- Item 1 - Two (2) Remote Operating Vehicles (ROV)
- Item 2 - Two (2) Three Claw Grabber
- Item 3 - Six (6) Underwater Inspection Poles
- Item 4 - Two (2) Side Scan Sonar

- (b) **A Valid certificate of Compliance issued in accordance with the National Insurance Act.**

Sealed tenders, in **DUPLICATE** on the approved Tender Forms will be received up to **1:00 p.m. on Thursday 10th September, 2009.**

Envelopes must be addressed to the Chairman, Central Tenders Board and clearly marked on the outside:-
