Tenders are invited for the Hire of Mechanical Equipment/Vehicles for the Ministry of Works and Transport on an 'as and when' required basis for a period of one (1) year 2009/2010.

Tender documents can be collected during normal working hours at the Central Tenders Board's Office, 116, Frederick Street, Port of Spain.

Tenderers are required to pay a tender deposit of Five Hundred Dollars (**\$500.00**) payable by cash or certified cheque to the Director of Contracts between the hours of 8.30 a.m. to 12.00 noon and 1.00 p.m. to 2.00 p.m. from Monday to Friday and **attach the original receipt** to their tender.

Tenders must be accompanied by:-

- (i) a valid **Income Tax Certificate**;
- (ii) a valid **Value Added Tax Clearance Certificate**; and
- (iii) a **Certificate of Compliance** issued in accordance with the National Insurance Act.

Sealed tenders in **DUPLICATE** must be addressed to the Chairman, Central Tenders Board and marked on the outside:-

"HIRE OF MECHANICAL EQUIPMENT/VEHICLES ON AN 'AS AND WHEN' REQUIRED BASIS FOR THE MINISTRY OF WORKS AND TRANSPORT 2009/2010"

The envelopes must be deposited in the **BROWN** Tenders Box located in the lobby of the Board's Office at the above address, no later than **1.00 P.M. THURSDAY APRIL 23, 2009.**

Tenderers are asked to note that the dimension of the slot in the Tenders Box is **37.5 cm x 5.5 cm**. Tenders should therefore be packaged accordingly.

Tenders will be opened shortly thereafter. The tenderer or his representative may be present at the opening.

Late tenders will NOT be considered in any circumstances.

The Board does not bind itself to accept the lowest or any other tender.

The Central Tenders Board reserves the right to cancel the present Notice in its entirety or even partially, without defraying any cost incurred by any firm in submitting their tender.
