Tender for the supply, delivery and installation of New Jersey Type Barriers for the Traffic Management Branch, Ministry of Works and Transport

Tenders are invited for the supply, delivery and installation of 724 New Jersey Type Longitudinal Barriers for placement along the median of Western Main Road, Cocorite for the Traffic Management Branch, Ministry of Works and Transport.

Tender documents may be obtained during normal working hours at the Central Tenders Board's Office, 116 Frederick Street, Port of Spain.

Any further information may be obtained during normal working hours from Mr. Dexter Wong Wai, Ag. Chief Traffic Engineer, Ministry of Works and Transport.

Tenders must be accompanied by the following:-

- (i) Valid Income Tax and Value Added Tax Clearance Certificates issued by the Board of Inland Revenue and dated not more than six (6) months prior to closing date for the receipt of tenders.
- (ii) Valid Certificate of Compliance issued in accordance with the National Insurance Act.

The original and three (3) copies of the Tender should be placed in a sealed envelope clearly marked:

“Tender for the supply, delivery and installation of New Jersey Type Barriers for the Traffic Management Branch, Ministry of Works and Transport”

The envelope addressed to the Chairman, Central Tenders Board, 116 Frederick Street, Port of Spain must be deposited in the **BROWN** Tenders Box located in the lobby of the Board's Office not later than **1.00pm on Thursday 17th January, 2008**.

Tenderers are asked to note that the dimensions of the slot of the Tenders Box are **37.5 cm x 5.5cm**.

Tenders will be opened publicly shortly thereafter. The tenderer or his representative may be present at the opening.

The Central Tenders Board reserves the right to cancel the bidding process in its entirety or even partially, without defraying any cost incurred by any firm submitting its tender.

Late tenders will **NOT** be considered under any circumstances.

The Board does not bind itself to accept the lowest or any other tender.
