The Government of the Republic of Trinidad and Tobago has received financing from the Inter-American Development Bank (IDB) and intends to apply part of the proceeds to payments under the project Electronic Government and Knowledge Brokering Program for Consultancy Services for the Provision of Business Process Management Support in the Public Service, Ministry of Public Administration.

The Central Tenders Board on behalf of the Ministry of Public Administration now invites sealed bids from eligible bidders for the services of a consulting firm for the provision of Business Process Management Support in the Public Service. The Ministry is embarking on a comprehensive Business Process Management Programme to enable Ministries, Departments and THA Divisions to improve their operational performance and monitoring and evaluation capability and to allow these agencies to achieve responsive and effective service delivery. It is required that the consulting firm should have relevant experience in managing service improvement projects and should possess the technical capacity in understanding business process management, business process re-engineering and organizational development within a public service environment. The duration of the assignment is twelve (12) months.

Bidding will be conducted through international competitive bidding procedures as specified in the Inter-American Development Bank's <u>Policies for Procurement of Works and Goods financed by the Inter-American Development Bank</u> (current edition), and is open to all eligible bidders as defined in the policies which can be found at website: http://www.iadb.org/procurement.

A pre-bid meeting will be held for prospective bidders on Monday 4 March, 2013 at 1.00 p.m. at the Ministry of Public Administration in the Old Fire Station Building, Hart Street Room, Corner Hart and Abercromby Streets, Port of Spain.

Proposals must be accompanied by the following where applicable:-.

- (i) Valid Income Tax and Value Added Tax Clearance Certificates issued by the Board of Inland Revenue and dated not more than six (6) months prior to the closing date for submission of proposals.
