- A merger of key information about taxpayers into one master database
- A tool to facilitate research or analysis on taxpayers
- A history of any changes made on Taxpayers record and by whom





Past System Weaknesses

- Comprised a mix of tax databases
 & manual storage systems
- Difficulty in acquiring Income Tax, PAYE, VAT & other tax-related info on a particular taxpayer
- Non-user friendly information screens & reports
- Difficulty in fulfilling the needs of stakeholders
- Lengthy wait for account updates and returns processing

System Objectives

- Faster processing of returns and updating of accounts
- Improved access to all information on a taxpayer to assist Compliance and Audit functions
- Better tracking of returns
- ·Improved service to all stakeholders
- ·Ability to easily produce management reports containing all tax data

Implementation of ITPS

- Phased Implementation ended December 2008
- The ITPS implementation consists of:
 - A tax administration software, GenTax
 - An Imaging system
 - Expanded network
 - Changed processes
 - Newly trained staff

Integrated Tax Processing System

Features & Benefits

Faster transaction processing

- Payments updated nightly
- Real-time Registration done for all tax types at all Regional Offices
- Real-time name or address changes
- Capability for e-filing and other electronic transactions

Greater availability of information

- Queries can be answered at any Regional Office
- Imaged Returns and other documents are easily available for viewing
- Ability to access info on the different types of taxes for a taxpayer
- Staff can view & attach notes to a taxpayer's account
- Information is accessible only by authorised staff

- Details on all tax types on a single system

- Tax data Integration allows for consistency of operations across all business functions and tax types.
