4. Those tenderers whose submissions meet the requirement of the Evaluation Committee will be invited to attend an interview during which they will have the opportunity to explain, clarify and to answer questions of the Committee.

5. Tenderers are required to submit the following:-

- (a) Valid Income Tax and Value Added Tax Clearance Certificates issued by the Board of Inland Revenue and dated not more than six (6) months prior to the closing date of the proposal.
- (b) An up-to-date Certificate of Compliance issued in accordance with the National Insurance Act.

One (1) original and three (3) copies of the proposal must be deposited in the BROWN Tenders Box located in the lobby of the Central Tenders Board's Office not later than <u>1.00 p.m. on</u> <u>Thursday May 24, 2007.</u> The envelopes must be addressed to the Chairman, Central Tenders Board and clearly marked on the outside:

Proposals will be opened publicly on the same day, immediately after the closing time at the Board's Office. A representative of the firm submitting a proposal may be present at the opening.
