Tenders are invited for the Demolition and Construction of a New Transport Building for the Penal Debe Regional Corporation, Ministry of Local Government.

Tender Documents can be obtained during normal working hours at the Central Tenders Board's Office, 116 Frederick Street, Port of Spain.

Tenderers are required to pay a tender deposit of \$500.00 payable by cash or certified cheque to the Director of Contracts, Central Tenders Board from Monday to Friday between the hours of 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon and 1:00 p.m. to 3:00 p.m. The original receipt must accompany the tender.

A pre-tender meeting followed by a site visit will be held at the Penal Debe Regional Corporation, #218A S.S. Erin Road Debe at **9:00 a.m. on Friday 27th July, 2012.**

Tenders must be accompanied by the following:-

- (i) Valid Income Tax and Value Added Tax Clearance Certificates issued by the Board of Inland Revenue and dated not more than six (6) months prior to the closing date of the tender.
- (ii) Valid Certificate of Compliance issued in accordance with the National Insurance Act.

The original Tender Document and one (1) copy must be placed in a sealed envelope addressed to the Chairman, Central Tenders Board, 116 Frederick Street, Port of Spain and clearly marked;

Envelopes must be deposited in the **BROWN** Tenders Box located in the lobby of the Board's Office not later than **1:00 p.m. on Thursday 09th August, 2012.**

Tenderers should note that the dimensions of the **slot** in the Tenders Box are **37.5 cm x 5.5 cm** and as such tenders should therefore be packaged accordingly.
