TENDER FOR THE SUPPLY AND DELIVERY OF MECHANICAL EQUIPMENT TO THE TUNAPUNA/PIARCO REGIONAL CORPORATION, MINISTRY OF LOCAL GOVERNMENT

Tenders are invited for the supply and delivery of Mechanical Equipment to the Tunapuna/Piarco Regional Corporation, Ministry of Local Government as follows:

- Item 1- One (1) 4 Wheel Drive Wheel Tractor with Tipping Trailer
- Item 2- One (1) 4 Wheel Drive Wheel Tractor with Brush Cutter
- Item 3- One (1) Brush Cutter Attachment

Tenders from locally registered firms must be accompanied by valid:

- (i) Income Tax and Value Added Tax Clearance Certificates issued by the Board of Inland Revenue and dated not more than six (6) months prior to the closing of the tender.
- (ii) Certificate of Compliance issued in accordance with the National Insurance Act.

Tenders on the approved tender forms **IN TRIPLICATE**, should be placed in sealed envelopes clearly marked on the outside:

Tenders will be opened publicly at the Board's Office shortly thereafter. The tenderer or his authorised representative may be present at the opening.

Tenderers should note that the dimensions of the **SLOT** of the Tenders Box are **37.5 cm x 5.5 cm** and tenders should be packaged accordingly.

Late tenders **will not** be considered in any circumstances.

The Board does not bind itself to accept the lowest or any other tender.

The Central Tenders Board reserves the right to cancel the bidding process in its entirety or even partially, without defraying any cost incurred by any firm in submitting their tender.
