Tender for the Upgrade of the Central Market for the Port of Spain City Corporation, Ministry of Local Government

Tenders are invited for the Upgrade of the Central Market, off Beetham Highway and Abattoir Road, Port of Spain for the Port of Spain City Corporation, Ministry of Local Government.

Tender documents can be obtained during normal working hours at the Central Tenders Board's Office, 116 Frederick Street, Port of Spain. A pre-tender meeting will be held for prospective tenderers at **10.00 a.m. on Thursday 15th August, 2013** at City Hall, 2-4 Knox Street, Port of Spain. A site visit will be arranged at the pre-tender meeting.

Tenders must be accompanied by the following:

- (i) **Valid Income Tax and Valued Added Tax Clearance Certificates** issued by the Board of Inland Revenue and dated not more than six (6) months prior to the closing date of the tender.
- (ii) A valid **Certificate of Compliance** issued in accordance with the National Insurance Act.

The original tender and one (1) copy must be placed in a sealed envelopes addressed to the **Chairman, Central Tenders Board**, 116 Frederick Street, Port of Spain and clearly marked on the outside: -

“Tender for the Upgrade of the Central Market for the Port of Spain City Corporation, Ministry of Local Government”

Envelopes must be deposited in the **BROWN** Tenders Box, located in the lobby of the Board's Office, 116 Frederick Street, Port of Spain, not later than **1:00 p.m. on THURSDAY 29th August, 2013.**

Tenderers should note that the dimensions of the **SLOT** of the Tenders Box are **37.5 cm x 5.5 cm** and, as such, tenders should be packaged accordingly.

Tenders will be opened shortly thereafter. The tenderer or his authorized representative may be present at the opening.

Late tenders will not be considered in any circumstances.

The Board does not bind itself to accept the lowest or any other tender.

The Central Tenders Board reserves the right to cancel the present notice in its entirety or even partially, without defraying any cost incurred by any firm in submitting their tender.
