Tenders are invited for the supply, delivery, installation and commissioning of one (1) 650 KVA standby generator and automatic transfer switch and associated electrical and civil works for the Ministry of National Security, Temple Court, 31-33 Abercromby Street, Port of Spain.

Tenders must be accompanied by the following:-

- (i) valid Income Tax and Value Added Tax Clearance Certificates issued by the Board of Inland Revenue and dated not more than six (6) months prior to the closing date of the tender.
- (ii) A valid Certificate of Compliance issued in accordance with the National Insurance Act.

Sealed tenders in **TRIPLICATE** must be addressed to the Chairman, Central Tenders Board and marked on the outside:-

"TENDER FOR THE SUPPLY, DELIVERY, INSTALLATION AND COMMISSIONING OF ONE (1) 650 KVA STANDBY GENERATOR AND AUTOMATIC TRANSFER SWITCH FOR THE MINISTRY OF NATIONAL SECURITY"

The envelopes must be deposited in the **BROWN** Tenders Box located in the lobby of the Board's Office at the above address, not later than **1.00 P.M. THURSDAY 18TH SEPTEMBER, 2008.**

Tenderers are asked to note that the dimension of the slot in the Tenders Box is **37.5 cm x 5.5 cm**. Tenders should therefore be packaged accordingly.

Tenders will be opened shortly thereafter. The tenderer or his representative may be present at the opening.

Late tenders will NOT be considered in any circumstances.

The Board does not bind itself to accept the lowest or any other tender.

The Central Tenders Board reserves the right to cancel the present Notice in its entirety or even partially, without defraying any cost incurred by any firm in submitting their tender.
