Tenders must be accompanied by valid:

- (i) Income Tax and Value Added Tax Clearance Certificates issued by the Board of Inland Revenue and dated not more than six (6) months prior to the closing date of the tender.
- (ii) Certificate of Compliance issued in accordance with the National Insurance Act.

Only original Certificates will be accepted:

The original and three (3) copies of the tender must be placed in a sealed envelopes addressed to the Chairman, Central Tenders Board, 116, Frederick Street, Port of Spain clearly marked:
