Tenders are invited for the removal of 135 existing fire hydrants and control valves and installation of replacements for the Trinidad and Tobago Fire Service, Ministry of National Security

Tender documents may be collected at the Central Tenders Board's Office, 116, Frederick Street, Port of Spain. Tenderers are required to pay a tender deposit of \$500.00 payable by Cash or certified cheque to the Director of Contracts and attach the official receipt to the tender. Payments will be received between the hours of **8:30 a.m. to 12:00 noon and 1:00 p.m. to 2:00 p.m on Mondays to Fridays.**

Tenders must be accompanied by the following:

- (a) valid Income Tax and Value Added Tax Clearance Certificates issued by the Board of Inland Revenue and dated not more than six (6) months prior to the closing date of the tender.
- (b) A valid Certificate of Compliance issued in accordance with the National Insurance Act.

Sealed tenders in **DUPLICATE** must be addressed to the Chairman, Central Tenders Board and marked on the outside:

Tenders will be opened shortly thereafter. The tenderer or his representative may be present at the opening.

Late tenders will **NOT** be considered in any circumstances.

The Board does not bind itself to accept the lowest or any other tender.

The Central Tenders Board reserves the right to cancel the present Notice in its entirety or even partially, without defraying any cost incurred by any firm in submitting its tender.
