- Item 4 - Four (4) Passenger Buses**

- (ii) Valid Certificate of Compliance issued in accordance with the National Insurance Act.

Sealed tenders in **TRIPLICATE** on the approved Tender Form will be received up to **1:00 p.m. on Thursday March 22, 2007.** Envelopes must be addressed to the Chairman, Central Tenders Board, #116 Frederick Street, Port of Spain and clearly marked on the outside:

and must be deposited in the **BROWN** Tenders Box located in the lobby of the Board's Office.
