Tender for the Supply, Delivery and Installation of New Jersey Type Barriers for the Traffic Management Branch, Ministry of Works and Transport

Tenders are invited for the supply, delivery and installation of New Jersey Type Longitudinal Barriers for the Traffic Management Branch, Ministry of Works and Transport as follows: -

- (1) 152 New Jersey Type Longitudinal Barriers for placement along the median of Uriah Butler Highway to Valpark;
- (2) 119 New Jersey Type Longitudinal Barriers for placement along the median of the Gulf View Link Road.

Tender documents may be obtained during normal working hours at the Central Tenders Board's Office, 116 Frederick Street, Port of Spain.

A pre-tender meeting and site visits are scheduled for: -

- (ii) **Tuesday 18th March, 2008 at 1.00 p.m. Nestle's Compound, Valpark.**

Separate contracts may be awarded for any one item or combination of items.

Tenders must be accompanied by the following:

- (i) Valid Income Tax and Valued Added Tax Clearance Certificates issued by the Board of Inland Revenue and dated not more than six (6) months prior to the closing date of tender.
- (ii) Valid Certificate of Compliance issued in accordance with the National Insurance Act.

The original and three (3) copies of the Tender should be placed in a sealed envelope clearly marked on the outside either: -

“Tender for the Supply, Delivery and Installation of 152 New Jersey Type Barriers for placement along the Uriah Butler Highway to Valpark for the Traffic Management Branch, Ministry of Works and Transport”

Or

“Tender for the Supply, Delivery and Installation of 119 New Jersey Type Barriers for placement along the Gulf View Link Road for the Traffic Management Branch, Ministry of Works and Transport”

The envelopes must be addressed to the Chairman, Central Tenders Board, 116 Frederick Street, Port of Spain and must be deposited in the **BROWN** Tenders Box located in the lobby of the Board’s Office not later than **1:00 p.m. on THURSDAY 27th MARCH, 2008.**

Tenderers are asked to note that the dimensions of the slot of the Tenders Box are, **37.5 cm x 5.5 cm** and, as such, tenders should be packaged accordingly.

Tenders will be opened shortly thereafter. The tenderer or his representative may be present at the opening.

Late tenders will not be considered in any circumstances.

The Board does not bind itself to accept the lowest or any other tender.

The Central Tenders Board reserves the right to cancel the present notice in its entirety or even partially, without defraying any cost incurred by any firm, in submitting their tender.
