Tenders are invited for the supply, delivery and installation of Two (2) Passenger Lifts at the Central Statistical Office, # 80 Independence Square, Port of Spain for the Ministry of Planning and Development.

Tender documents may be obtained during normal working hours at the Central Tenders Board's Office, 116 Frederick Street, Port of Spain.

Tenderers are required to pay a tender deposit of **one hundred dollars (\$100.00)** by cash or certified cheque to the Director of Contracts. The original receipt must be attached to the tender.

A site visit is scheduled for Monday January 08, 2007 at 10.00 am at the Central Statistical Office, #80 Independence Square, Port of Spain.

Tenders must be accompanied by the following:

- (a) Valid Income Tax and Value Added Tax Clearance Certificates issued by the Board of Inland Revenue and dated not more than six (6) months prior to the closing date of the tender.
- (b) A valid Certificate of Compliance issued in accordance with the National Insurance Act.

Sealed tenders in **DUPLICATE** on the approved Tender Form will be received up to **1:00 p.m. on Thursday January 25, 2007.** Envelopes must be addressed to the Chairman, Central Tenders Board, 116 Frederick Street, Port of Spain and marked on the outside:-

and must be deposited in the **BROWN** Tenders Box located in the lobby of the Board's Office.

Tenderers are asked to note that the size of the slot in the Tenders Box is **37.5 cm x 5.5 cm**. Tenders should be packaged accordingly.

Tenders will be opened shortly thereafter. The tenderer or his representative may be present at the opening.

The Central Tenders Board reserves the right to cancel the bidding process in its entirety or even partially, without defraying any cost incurred by any firm submitting its tender.

Late tenders will **NOT** be considered in any circumstances.
