Tenders are invited for the supply and delivery of two (2) Vehicles and five (5) items of Mechanical Equipment to the Highways Division, Ministry of Works and Transport as follows:-

VEHICLES

Item 1 – Eight (8) Flat Bed Trucks (Crew Cab) with three piece drop sides

Item 2 – Two (2) Double Cab 4x4 Light Trucks

MECHANICAL EQUIPMENT

Item 1 - Six (6) Trailers with Hoist

Item 2 – One (1) Motor Grader

Item 3 – Four (4) Vibratory Rollers

Item 4 - Five (5) 3 – 5 Tonne Dump Trucks with three piece drop sides

Item 5 –Two (2) 6 - 9 Tonne Dump Trucks

- (1) Valid Income Tax and Value Added Tax Clearance Certificates issued by the Board of Inland Revenue and dated not more than six (6) months prior to the closing date of the tender.
- (2) Valid Certificate of Compliance issued in accordance with the National Insurance Act.

Sealed tenders in **DUPLICATE** on the approved Tender Form will be received up to **1.00 p.m. on Thursday July 12, 2007.** Envelopes must be addressed to the Chairman, Central Tenders Board, 116 Frederick Street, Port of Spain and marked on the outside:

OR

“Tender for the Supply and Delivery of Mechanical Equipment to the Highways Division, Ministry of Works and Transport”

and must be deposited in the **BROWN** Tenders Box located in the lobby of the Board’s Office.

Tenders will be opened shortly thereafter. The tenderer or a representative may be present at the opening.

Tenderers are asked to note that the dimensions of the **slot** in the Tenders Box are **37.5 cm x 5.5 cm.** Tenders should therefore be packaged accordingly.

The Central Tenders Board reserves the right to cancel the present notice in its entirety or even partially, without defraying any cost incurred by any firm in submitting their tender.

Late tenders will **NOT** be considered in any circumstances.
