

TENDER NOTICE

CENTRAL TENDERS BOARD

Tender for the Purchase of Used Automotive Batteries belonging to the Government of the Republic of Trinidad and Tobago for a period of one (1) year

Tenders are invited for the purchase of used automotive batteries belonging to the Government of the Republic of Trinidad and Tobago for a period of one (1) year commencing July 1st, 2007.

Tender documents may be obtained during normal working hours at the Central Tenders Board's Office, 116 Frederick Street, Port of Spain. Any further technical information may be obtained from Mr. Glen Goddard, Manager, Pollution Prevention & Control Services Division, Environmental Management Authority (EMA), #8 Elizabeth Street, St Clair, Port of Spain at Telephone Nos. 628-8042, 8044/5 Ext. 293 Or 285.

Tenderers must include in their tender a detailed statement on the methods to be employed in handling, sorting and disposing of the used batteries.

Tenders must also be accompanied by the following: -

- (i) Valid Income Tax and Value Added Tax Clearance Certificates issued by the Board of Inland Revenue dated not more than six (6) months prior to the closing date of the tender.
- (ii) A Compliance Certificate issued in accordance with the National Insurance Act.

The successful tenderer will be required to pay a Cash Performance Deposit or provide a Bond in the sum of two thousand, five hundred dollars (\$2,500.00) as a guarantee for the proper performance of the contract.

The tender on the approved tender form (in duplicate) should be placed in a sealed envelope clearly marked on the outside: -

“Tender for the Purchase of Used Automotive Batteries belonging to the Government of the Republic of Trinidad and Tobago for a period of one (1) year.”

and must be addressed to the Chairman, Central Tenders Board, 116 Frederick Street, Port of Spain. Tenders must be deposited in the **BROWN** Tenders Box located in the lobby of the Board's Office not later than **1.00 p.m. on Thursday 24th May, 2007.**

Tenderers should note that the dimension of the slot of the Tenders Box is 37.5 cm x 5.5 cm and as such tenders should be packaged accordingly.

Tenders will be opened publicly at the Board's Office shortly thereafter. The tenderer or his representative may be present at the opening.

The Board reserves the right to cancel the present notice in its entirety or even partially, without defraying any cost incurred by any tenderer in submitting their tender.

Late tenders will **NOT** be considered in any circumstances.

The Board does not bind itself to accept the lowest or any other tender.
