Tenders are invited for the supply and installation of Marine Aids to Navigation (Buoys) at locations throughout Trinidad and Tobago for the Maritime Services Division, Ministry of Transport.

- (a) **Income Tax and Value Added Tax Clearance Certificates issued by the Board of Inland Revenue and dated not more than six (6) months prior to the closing date of tender.**
- (b) **Certificate of Compliance issued in accordance with the National Insurance Act.**

The original and six (6) copies of the Tender should be placed in sealed envelopes addressed to the Chairman, Central Tenders Board, 116 Frederick Street, Port of Spain. Envelopes must be deposited in the **BROWN** Tenders Box located in the lobby of the Board's Office not later than **1:00p.m. on Thursday September 11, 2014.**

Envelopes must be clearly marked on the outside:-
