The Government of Trinidad & Tobago, through the Ministry of National Security has received financing from *the Inter-American Development Bank (IDB)*, and intends to apply part of the proceeds to projects designed by the Citizen Security Programme to contribute to the reduction of crime and violence within 22 "high needs" communities throughout Trinidad and Tobago.

The specific objectives of the Programme are (i) the reduction in the levels of homicides, robberies and woundings in partner communities; (ii) an increase in the perception of safety in the partner communities; (iii) a reduction of injuries related to firearms, child maltreatment, domestic violence and youth violence; and (iv) an increase in the collective efficacy to prevent violence in the partner communities.

To this end, the Programme's activities have been organized into three (3) main components: (1) Community Action; (2) Assistance to the Trinidad and Tobago Police Service (TTPS); and (3) Institutional Strengthening of the Ministry of National Security.

CSP hopes that at the close of its project, there would be stronger communities, vibrant and more organised than prior to CSP's introduction in 2008. For this reason, it is being proposed that each community develop a Safety Plan with clearly articulated vision for the safety of the community, a set of well defined, measurable activities with resource requirements and opportunities for close collaboration with external stakeholders clearly outlined. This is a key component of the exit- strategy of the CSP upon the close of the Programme. This activity is therefore viewed as critical.

The Central Tenders Board on behalf of the Ministry of National Security now invites sealed bids from eligible bidders for Technical Assistance in the Establishment of Community Safety Plans in CSP Partner Communities.

The duration of the assignment is fifteen (15) months.
