Tenders are invited for the Replacement of a Cylinder Crossing across Couva/Preysal Interchange for the Ministry of Works and Transport.

Tender documents can be obtained during normal working hours at the Central Tenders Board's Office, 116 Frederick Street, Port of Spain, Telephone No. 625-3577 or 625-3565.

Tenderers are required to pay a tender deposit of **One Thousand dollars (\$1000.00)** payable by cash or certified cheque to the Director of Contracts, Central Tenders Board. This deposit will be received on normal working days, Monday to Friday between the hours of 9.00 a.m. to 12.00 noon and 1.00 p.m. to 3.00 p.m. The original receipt must be attached to the tender.

A pre-tender meeting followed by a site visit will be held for prospective tenderers at 10.00 am on Friday September 07, 2018 at the Couva/Preysal Interchange, Sir Solomon Hochoy Highway.

Tenders must be accompanied by the following:

- (i) Valid Income Tax and Valued Added Tax Clearance Certificates issued by the Board of Inland Revenue and dated not more than six (6) months prior to the closing date of the tender.
- (ii) A Valid Certificate of Compliance issued in accordance with the National Insurance Act.

The original and five (5) copies of the Tender should be placed in sealed envelopes clearly marked on the outside: -

“Tender for the Replacement of a Cylinder Crossing across Couva/Preysal Interchange for the Ministry of Works and Transport”

Envelopes must be addressed to the Chairman, Central Tenders Board, 116 Frederick Street, Port of Spain. Tenders must be deposited in the **BROWN** Tenders Box, located in the lobby of the Board's Office not later than **1:00 p.m. on Thursday September 20, 2018.**
