## TENDER NOTICE

### HIRE OF MECHANICAL EQUIPMENT/VEHICLES FOR THE MINISTRY OF WORKS AND TRANSPORT ON AN “AS AND WHEN REQUIRED” BASIS FOR A PERIOD OF ONE (1) YEAR

Tenders are invited for the Hire of Mechanical Equipment/Vehicles on an “as and when required” basis for the Ministry of Works and Transport for a period of one (1) year.

Tender documents can be obtained during normal working hours at the Central Tenders Board’s Office, 116 Frederick Street, Port of Spain. Telephone numbers: 625-3565 or 625-4330.

Tenderers are required to pay a tender deposit of **one thousand dollars (\$1000.00)** payable by cash or certified cheque to the Director of Contracts, Central Tenders Board, 116 Frederick Street, Port of Spain. This deposit will be received from **Monday to Friday between the hours of 9.00 a.m. to 12.00 noon and 1.00 p.m. to 3.00 p.m.** The original receipt must be attached to the tender.

Any further technical information may be obtained during normal working hours from Mr. Ronney Seepersad, Drainage Engineer (Ag), Ministry of Works and Transport at telephone number 290-0165.

Tenders must be accompanied by the following:

- (i) Valid Income Tax and Value Added Tax Clearance Certificates issued by the Board of Inland Revenue and dated not more than six (6) months prior to the closing date of tender.
- (ii) Valid Certificate of Compliance issued in accordance with the National Insurance Act.

The **original tender and a copy** on the approved tender form should be placed in sealed envelopes clearly marked on the outside:-

Envelopes must be addressed to the Chairman, Central Tenders Board, 116 Frederick Street, Port of Spain and must be deposited in the **BROWN** Tenders Box located in the lobby of the Board’s Office not later than **1.00 p.m. on Thursday January 31, 2019.**

Tenderers should note that the dimensions of the slot in the Tenders Box are **37.5 cm x 5.5 cm** and as such, tenders should be packaged accordingly.

Tenders will be opened shortly thereafter. The tenderer or an authorized representative may be present at the opening.

Late tenders will **NOT** be considered in any circumstances.

The Board does not bind itself to accept the lowest or any other tender.

The Central Tenders Board reserves the right to cancel the present notice in its entirety or even partially, without defraying any cost incurred by any firm, in submitting their tender.
