Proposals must be accompanied by the following:-

- (a) Valid Income Tax and Value Added Tax Clearance Certificates issued by the Board of Inland Revenue and dated not more than six (6) months prior to the closing date for submission of proposals (*applicable to local consultants*).
- (b) Valid Certificate of Compliance issued in accordance with the National Insurance Act (*applicable to local consultants*).

The original and six (6) copies each of the Technical and Financial Proposals should be placed in separate sealed envelopes addressed to the Chairman, Central Tenders Board, 116 Frederick Street, Port of Spain.

The Technical Proposals will be opened shortly thereafter. The Consultant or an authorized representative may be present at the opening.

Consultants should note that the dimensions of the **SLOT** in the Tenders Box are **37.5 cm x 5.5 cm** and as such, proposals should be packaged accordingly.

Late proposals **will not** be considered in any circumstances.

The Board does not bind itself to accept any proposal.
