Tenders are invited for the Supply, Installation, Commissioning and Testing of One (1) Drainage Pump and Engine Assembly for the Plum Mitan Project, Ministry of Agriculture, Land and Fisheries.

A pre-tender meeting followed by a site visit will be held for prospective tenderers at 10.00 am on Friday July 19, 2019 at Caltoo Trace, Plum Mitan.

Tenders must be accompanied by the following:

- (i) Valid Income Tax and Value Added Tax Clearance Certificates issued by the Board of Inland Revenue and dated not more than six (6) months prior to the closing date of tender.
- (ii) Valid Certificate of Compliance issued in accordance with the National Insurance Act.

The **original tender and a copy** should be placed in sealed envelopes clearly marked on the outside:-

“Tender for the Supply, Installation, Commissioning and Testing of One (1) Drainage Pump and Engine Assembly for the Plum Mitan Project, Ministry of Agriculture, Land and Fisheries”

Tenderers should note that the dimensions of the slot in the Tenders Box are **37.5 cm x 5.5 cm** and as such, tenders should be packaged accordingly.

Tenders will be opened shortly thereafter. The tenderer or an authorized representative may be present at the opening.

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Late tenders will **NOT** be considered in any circumstances.

The Board does not bind itself to accept the lowest or any other tender.
