Tenders are invited for the Supply and Installation of Two (2) Metal Storage Containers at the Piarco/Tunapuna Regional Corporation Disaster Management Unit, Macoya, Ministry of Rural Development and Local Government.

A pre-tender meeting followed by a site visit will be held for prospective tenderers at **10.00 a.m.** on **Friday 26th July, 2019** at the Tunapuna/Piarco Regional Corporation Technical Building, Centenary Street, Tunapuna.

Tenders must be accompanied by the following:

- (i) Valid Income Tax and Valued Added Tax Clearance Certificates issued by the Board of Inland Revenue and dated not more than six (6) months prior to the closing date of the tender.
- (ii) A Valid Certificate of Compliance issued in accordance with the National Insurance Act.

The **original and three (3) copies** of the Tender should be placed in sealed envelopes clearly marked on the outside: -

“Tender for Supply and Installation of Two (2) Metal Storage Containers at the Tunapuna/Piarco Regional Corporation Disaster Management Unit, Macoya, Ministry of Rural Development and Local Government”.

Envelopes must be addressed to the Chairman, Central Tenders Board, 116 Frederick Street, Port of Spain. Tenders must be deposited in the **BROWN** Tenders Box, located in the lobby of the Board's Office not later than **1:00 p.m. on THURSDAY 08th August, 2018.**

Tenders will be opened shortly thereafter. The tenderer or an authorised representative may be present at the opening.

Tenderers should note that the dimensions of the **SLOT** in the Tenders Box are **37.5 cm x 5.5cm** and as such, tenders should be packaged accordingly.

Late tenders will not be considered in any circumstances.

The Board does not bind itself to accept the lowest or any other tender.

The Central Tenders Board reserves the right to cancel the bidding process in its entirety or even partially, without defraying any cost incurred by any firm in submitting their tender.
