- Item 1 - One (1) Command Vehicle
- Item 2 - Four (4) Utility Pick Ups

Tenders must be accompanied by **valid**:-

- (a) Income Tax and Value Added Tax Clearance Certificates issued by the Board of Inland Revenue and dated not more than six (6) months prior to the closing date of tender (applicable to local firms only).
- (b) Certificate of Compliance issued in accordance with the National Insurance Act (applicable to local firms only).

The original tender on the approved Tender Forms and a copy should be placed in sealed envelopes clearly marked on the outside:-

“Tender for the Supply and Delivery of Vehicles to the Trinidad and Tobago Fire Service, Ministry of National Security”

Envelopes must be addressed to the Chairman, Central Tenders Board, 116 Frederick Street, Port of Spain and must be deposited in the **BROWN** Tenders Box located in the lobby of the Board's Office not later than **1:00 PM ON THURSDAY APRIL 09, 2020**.

Tenders will be opened publicly at the Board's Office shortly thereafter. The tenderer or an authorized representative may be present at the opening.

Tenderers should note that the dimensions of the **SLOT** in the Tenders Box are **37.5 cm x 5.5 cm** and as such, tenders should be packaged accordingly.

Late tenders **will not** be considered in any circumstances.

The Board does not bind itself to accept the lowest or any other tender.

The Central Tenders Board reserves the right to cancel the present process in its entirety or partially, without defraying any cost incurred by any firm in submitting their tender.
