A **Pre-Tender Meeting** will be held for prospective tenderers at the Arima Borough Corporation, Cor. O'Connor Drive and O'Meara Road, Arima followed by a **Site Visit** to the Arima Municipal Police Post, Sanchez Street, Arima on **Friday July 24, 2020 at 10.30 a.m.**

Tenders must be accompanied by:-

- (i) valid **Income Tax** and **Value Added Tax Clearance Certificates** issued by the Board of Inland Revenue and dated not more than six (6) months prior to the closing date of the tender (applicable to local firms).
- (ii) valid **Certificate of Compliance** issued in accordance with the National Insurance Act (applicable to local firms).

The **original tender** and **three (3) copies** must be placed in sealed envelopes, addressed to the Chairman, Central Tenders Board, 116 Frederick Street, Port of Spain and **clearly marked** on the outside:-

Envelopes must be deposited in the **BROWN** Tenders Box located in the lobby of the Board's Office not later than **1.00 p.m. on THURSDAY AUGUST 06, 2020.**

Tenderers should note that the dimensions of the **SLOT** in the Tenders Box are **37.5 cm x 5.5 cm** and tenders should therefore be packaged accordingly.

The tender opening will be streamed live via Webex and Tenderers shall be provided with a link that will connect them to the live proceedings.
