Tenders are invited for the Maintenance and Servicing of Traffic Control Signals for the Traffic Management Branch, Ministry of Works and Transport for a period of three (3) years.

A pre-tender meeting will be held for prospective tenderers at **9.30 a.m. on Monday 11th July, 2022** in the Conference Room of the Traffic Management Branch, Ministry of Works and Transport, Licensing Office, (2nd Floor) Frederick Settlement, Caroni.

Tenders must be accompanied by the following:

- (ii) **Valid Income Tax and Valued Added Tax Clearance Certificates** issued by the Board of Inland Revenue and dated not more than six (6) months prior to the closing date of the tender. (Applicable to local firms only)
- (iii) **A Valid Certificate of Compliance** issued in accordance with the National Insurance Act. (Applicable to local firms only)

The original and seven (7) copies of the Tender should be placed in sealed envelopes, addressed to the **Chairman, Central Tenders Board, 116 Frederick Street, Port of Spain** and clearly marked on the outside: -

“Tender for Maintenance and Servicing of Traffic Control Signals for the Traffic Management Branch, Ministry of Works and Transport for a period of three (3) years”

Envelopes must be deposited in the **BROWN** Tenders Box, located in the lobby of the Board's Office, 116 Frederick Street, Port of Spain, not later than **1:00 p.m. on THURSDAY July 21, 2022.**

Tenderers should note that the dimensions of the **SLOT** in the Tenders Box are **37.5 cm x 5.5 cm** and as such, tenders should be packaged accordingly.

Tenders will be opened publicly at the Board's Office shortly thereafter. The tenderer or an authorized representative may be present at the opening.

Late tenders **will not** be considered in any circumstances.

The Board does not bind itself to accept the lowest or any other tender.

The Central Tenders Board reserves the right to cancel the bidding process in its entirety or partially, without defraying any cost incurred by any firm in submitting their tender.
