A pre-tender meeting/site visit will be held for prospective tenderers at **10.00 a.m.** on **Tuesday August 23, 2022** at Trinidad and Tobago Coast Guard's Tobago Operations Base, Harbour Main Street, Scarborough, Tobago.

Tenders must be accompanied by the following:

- (ii) **Valid Income Tax and Valued Added Tax Clearance Certificates** issued by the Board of Inland Revenue and dated not more than six (6) months prior to the closing date of the tender. (Applicable to local firms only)
- (iii) **A Valid Certificate of Compliance** issued in accordance with the National Insurance Act. (Applicable to local firms only)

The original and five (5) copies each of the Tender should be placed in sealed envelopes, addressed to the **Chairman, Central Tenders Board, 116 Frederick Street, Port of Spain** and clearly marked on the outside: -
