CUSTOMS AND EXCISE DIVISION SEIZES NARCOTICS VALUED AT OVER TT\$10 MILLION

During routine operational activities conducted over the past week, Officers of the Customs and Excise Division executed four (4) separate narcotics seizures.

These interceptions resulted in the confiscation of 38.998 Kilograms of Marijuana, 8 ampoules of Fentanyl, 1 vial of Ketamine and 0.606 Kilograms of Methylenedioxymethamphetamine (MDMA).

The seized Marijuana carries an estimated street value of TT\$9,737,800.00, while the MDMA carries an estimated street value of TT\$1,515,000.00.

These successful operations highlight the Division's unwavering commitment to protecting the borders of Trinidad and Tobago from the illicit narcotics trade and other forms of smuggling that pose risks to public health, safety, and national security. The Customs and Excise Division continues to employ intelligence-driven strategies, advanced screening techniques, and strong interagency collaboration to combat the movement of prohibited and restricted goods.

Several individuals were arrested in relation to these seizures and have since appeared before the Magistrates' Court. Investigations remain ongoing.
