DECLARATION OF CURRENCY OR MONETARY INSTRUMENTS



ALL ARRIVING AND DEPARTING PASSENGERS are advised that they are required to **DECLARE** to a **Customs Officer** on duty at the Airport or Sea port whether they are carrying cash currency or monetary instruments in excess of **Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000) USD** or its equivalent in any currency or **Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000) TTD**.



Bearer Negotiable Instruments include Travellers' Cheques, Promissory Notes, Bills of Exchange and Bank Drafts.



ALL ARRIVING AND DEPARTING PASSENGERS ARE WARNED THAT THE MAKING OF A FALSE DECLARATION WITH RESPECT TO THE AMOUNT OF CASH OR THE VALUE OF MONETARY INSTRUMENTS BEING CARRIED MAY RESULT IN SEVERE PENALTIES.
